

EFEM Travel Grants – Reminder for 2015

The stated purpose of the European Federation for Experimental Morphology is the advancement of science and education related to experimental morphology in the European region. This is realised, *inter alia*, by promoting information exchange, both scientific and professional; encouraging joint meetings, supporting scientific training and exchanges; organizing the EFEM Lecture; facilitating training programs in morphological education; and considering ethical matters pertaining to morphology.

The EFEM is offering up to 4 research travel grants, each of €750, for 2015. In accordance with the EFEM Statutes §2

The objectives include stimulation and facilitation of

- training [scientific and professional]
- international scientific research projects in morphological fields
- information exchange, including meetings.

The Grants are intended for travel between anatomical and morphological institutes in Europe.

Applicants shall be members of a Constituent Society of the EFEM which has paid its annual EFEM membership dues to date.

Applications should include: (1) the request with the explanation of the purpose of the trip and (2) CV with Bibliography of the applicant.

Closing date for applications is Sunday March 1, 2015
