Abstracts must be sent in the format specified below:

• Language: English

• Abstract size: Maximum 250 words

Font type: CalibriFont size: 12

• Line spacing: Single

• Title: In Bold.

- **Authors**: Authors should be listed giving their family name first, followed by their initials, as indicated in the example below.
- The presenting author's name should be underlined.
- **Author affiliation**: It should include only department, institution and city; please do not list full postal addresses.
- **Abstract main text**: It must concisely report the introduction, objectives, material and methods, results and conclusions.
- Please do not include references.
- Funding sources and other acknowledgements may be listed at the end of the text.
