ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Oral communications are solicited on any topic related to the teaching of anatomy.
- The Deadline for abstract submission is **January 15, 2018**.
- Abstracts must be sent to isabel.stabile@um.edu.mt as pdf files attached to an e-mail message.
- Each registered author may only present one Abstract.
- Oral communications should be prepared as Microsoft PowerPoint (ppt) files (version 2003 or later). Presentation time will be 10 minutes.
- Abstracts accepted for presentation will be published in the **European Journal of Anatomy**.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

Abstracts must be sent in the format specified below:

- **Language:** English
- **Abstract size:** Maximum 250 words
- **Font type:** Calibri
- **Font size:** 12
- **Line spacing:** Single
- **Title:** In Bold.
- **Authors:** Authors should be listed giving their family name first, followed by their initials, as indicated in the example below.
- The presenting author's name should be underlined.
- **Author affiliation:** It should include only department, institution and city; please do not list full postal addresses.
- **Abstract main text:** It must concisely report the introduction, objectives, material and methods, results and conclusions.
- **Please** do not include references.
- **Funding sources and other acknowledgements** may be listed at the end of the text.
